Rules for 2012 Season

Registration and Take Off

Registration will take place weekly between 4:45pm. and 5:45pm. Entry fee is \$15 per person, per event. Up to three take off positions will be reserved for volunteer release boats on a first come first serve basis. A team may not volunteer two consecutive weeks unless no other teams are interested. **All tournaments will be limited to 19 boats, first come, first served!** No reservations or prepayments for other participants accepted. If there is a shortage of release boats, the Tournament Directors will volunteer or assign as needed. All non-release boats will be assigned by draw the day of the tournament. Boats must have working live wells. Last boat out will check live wells. **Tournament Directors may delay take off or cancel any event (including the Championship) due to weather conditions. Take off location can not change.**

Weigh In

Teams must be inside nearest launch site "Slow No Wake" buoy by weigh-in. **Late is late and fish will not be scored!** Teams must report their catch to the tournament Directors before taking their boat out of the water. One largemouth or smallmouth bass may be scored per angler. Fish will be measured to the nearest 1/8" with tail fanned to longest position. Dead fish (or almost) will not be scored. Short fish will result in both angler and team disqualification for the night. Fish must be at least 14" or 18" on Mendota.

Standings

Tournament participants must declare whether they will be fishing as a **Team** or **Individual Angler** at each event for the entire season.

TEAMS

In order to qualify for **Team** length standings you must have the *same partner* for the entire season. Each **Team** will be allowed 1 substitute angler **for a maximum of 2 events** *or* a team member may pay double entry and fish alone and score 2 fish (except on Mendota) **for a maximum of 2 events**. Only **Team** members or substitutes are allowed in the boat during each event.

If a Team member fishes alone and does not pay a double entry fee, their catch will not be scored toward Team length, but will count toward AOY.

Any 2 anglers who fish out of the same boat will be scored as a team!

INDIVIDUAL ANGLER

An angler **must fish alone** to be scored as an **Individual Angler**.

Scoring

Angler of the Year(AOY)

AOY will be determined by greatest individual total length at the end of the season.

Standings

Team and Individual Angler standings will be based on total length.

Mendota-Anywhere without locking.
Monona-Below Tenney dam to Beltline
Waubesa-Beltline to Lower Mud
Kegonsa-Lower Mud to CTH B

Championship Event

Up to 12 **Team** boats and 1 **Individual Angler** could earn a spot to fish in the Championship tournament. To qualify for the Championship you must:

-Finish in the top 12 **Team** OR number 1 **Individual Angler** total length standings after the August 21st, event.

(Big Bass Breaks Tie For Either)

AND!!!!

-Fish at least 13 of the 16 events.

Some participation exceptions may be made for anglers having **serious** medical conditions or surgery.

Sportsmanship and Safety

All local and state boating regulations apply. There will be zero tolerance for unsportsmanlike conduct on the water or at the launch site. Live bait or trolling is not allowed. "Stocking" or moving fish is not allowed. One rod in water per angler. Tournament Directors reserve the right to disqualify participants for unsportsmanlike conduct toward anyone on the water or at the landing for an event or the season. All complaints will be reviewed by Director and 2 designated judges.
